

Result of Consultation on Non-Designated Heritage Assets

Following the publication of the Non-Designated Heritage Assets list in the Spring edition of The Grapevine, responses were received from a number of parishioners.

These responses included:

- a) Those who submitted additional detail about properties which have been incorporated into the final report
- b) Those who agreed with the list and were happy for it to be added to the supporting detail of the Neighbourhood Plan
- c) Those who commented that they had not previously realised the amount of interesting information and history about the parish
- d) Those who suggested there were omissions from the list

These were duly considered and it has been agreed that the property known as The Fox in Lewknor High Street and The Burial Path between Postcombe and Lewknor are considered to meet the Non Designated Heritage Asset criteria and have therefore been added to the list.

The following are brief descriptions of the additions:-

- I) The Fox is a detached private dwelling, previously known as the Fox Inn. Little evidence of its former use is apparent, however the building is important to the visual image of the High Street.
- II) The Funeral Path connects Postcombe and Lewknor. The footpath leaves Postcombe in Salt Lane, crosses the field toward Nethercote Lane (which it now crosses under the motorway). It then follows the field edge to the rear of the parish church. The name derives from its use as the route along which coffins were taken to get to the church.
